Skills

My main current activities include technical documentation, Unix architecture and administration, and, occasionally, responding to incoming bids for many kind of customers, either in French (mainly) or in English.

I have used and managed most of the different Unix brands available on the market, either proprietary (Solaris, AIX, Tru64, HP-UX) or free (Red Hat Linux 4 → RHAS3, Mandriva Linux 5.1 → 10.2, Debian, OpenBSD).

I also master the LAMP suite, OpenLDAP, Samba (as NT4 PDC), squid, NetFilter and many more technologies.

I have programmed in C, shell (POSIX as ksh or bash), and Perl. Currently using shell and Perl on a regular basis (many Perl modules on CPAN).

I also have skills in conceiving, implementing and administration of LDAP directories, with OpenLDAP 2.x and Sun Directory Server 5.x.

I used to be a Sybase DBA until 2002.

Work experience

Since February 1996:

I have been working for nearly ten years at LogicaCMG, evolving from assingment to assignment, the company growing by buying or being bought. Four periods in my experience :

- May 2000 – Current: Consulting and technical expertise, pour all client typology, and any type of infrastructure architecture. This involves pre-sales on my missions or on particular technologies on big leads.
- June 2002 – December 2004: Construction and management of an ASP infrastructure (LogicaCMG's Global Payare offer, based on SAP/HR), drastical cost reduction for investments due to a massive but reasoned use of free and open source software (FOSS, all except SAP, Oracle and the EAI: CFI).
- March 1998 – May 2000: Technical account manager. Managed about 40 consultants working at different customer sites, no resign despite being in a high turnover period.
- February 1996 – March 1998: Consulting. Two succesful missions, one being involved in the emergency reconstruction of the production infrastructure of the bank's front office which disappeared because of the head-office fire.

Consulting and technical expertise (May 2000 – present)

Notable achievements:

- 2005 - Crédit Agricole S.A. / SILCA: reorganisation of the system support team, Unix and LDAP administration, introduced FOSS (ticketing and documentation), documentation writing and FOSS advocacy.
- 2005 - DGGN (*Gendarmerie Nationale* HQ): product, system and architecture consulting during the definition et and the preparation of the implementation public procurement contract regarding the total renewal of central IT infrastructure.
- 2002 – 2004 : see below
- 2004 - Groupe BPI: Implemented a central (replicated) LDAP directory, used as a SSO medium for Windows clients (NT4 domain control with Samba), CheckPoint VPN clients, etc. 100€ saved (licensing) per PC.
- 2002 - *Direction Générale des Impôts* (DGI, french IRS): complete study (installed base, state of the art, analysis, solution proposition: use FOSS) to replace all the infrastructure management software tools. The DGI choose to use FOSS for these needs after this study.
- 2001 - Aventis Pharma: installation of a compute farm (20 Linux nodes) with front-end servers (Linux & Tru64, with HSG80 SAN attachements)
- 2000 - Crédit Lyonnais: complete study (installed base, state of the art, analysis, solution proposition) about storage rationalization and SAN.

Construction & management of an ASP infrastructure (June 2002 – December 2004)

In the Managed Services division at LogicaCMG (SAP/HR based application and solution hosting), construction of the system infrastructure jointly with the network engineer. The platform entered production in december 2002, while the project begun in May 2002. Services offered are: system infrastructure for SAP and Oracle on Solaris and Linux (Red Hat and SuSE), supervision, computing evaluation for systems and networks, CFT payroll transfers to the printer partner, security (all data streams are identified, filtered and separated), organization of the support team (Request Tracker), documentation of the whole infrastructure.

Technical account manager (March 1998 – May 2000)

Operational follow-up of about 40 system, network, database engineers as a “project manager”.

- Technical follow-up of the missions, training needs, and skills inventory;
- Cultivation of consultants loyalty;
- Yearly appraisals, career management;

One of the “project manager” tasks was recruitment:

- 1999 : 22 engineers recruited;
